Zoom administrator account

- One or few based on requirement
- Sub admin accounts pending in zoom development
- Zoom admin has to create and manage accounts for everybody (1000 accounts)



Zoom integration with NREN identity Federation

- Technology used SAML (ver 2)
 - SAML
 - Security Assertion Markup Language (SAML) is an open standard that allows identity providers (IdP) to pass authorization credentials to service providers (SP)
- What is required?
 - IDP Identity provider(s) maintained by your campuses
 - SP Service provider(s) (service Zoom by maintained Zoom)
 - Federation Registry NREN has to maintain
 - All IDPs have to be registered
 - All **SP**s have to be registered


Identity Federation

- Three Components
 - 1. Federation Registry
 - Jagger
 - 2. IDB and IDP Identity provider service alone with identity database
 - LDAP and Shibboleth
 - 3. Service Providers
 - In our case, it is Zoom

Prerequisite

- Basic Linux administration experience
 - Installing Linux OS (with partitioning disk, network configuration)
 - Ubuntu 18.04 LTS (support until April 2023)
 - OS package management (installation and upgrading)
 - General shell commands
 - Editing text files (configuration file) using VIM or NANO editor

 - Intel/AMD Server (PC) or VM with 8GB RAM, 100GB disk
 - Satosa proxy
 - Intel/AMD Server (PC) or VM with 8GB RAM, 50GB disk

 - Intel/AMD Server (PC) or VM with 8 GB RAM, 100GB disk
- For Institutional side (LDAP and Shibboleth)
 - Intel/AMD Server (PC) or VM with 8 GB RAM, 200GB disk
